

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome back! We are all very excited to welcome our students back on Sunday 21st February 2021. We sincerely believe that your return will bring back the school's spirit again.

Below you will find the relevant details and information for your daughters' return:

- KGs and Elementary graders (Gr.1 to Gr.5) are expected to come to school starting from Sunday 21st
 Feb 2021, 4 days/week, Sunday-Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday. Thursday is a day-off for the whole
 school.
- Middle School will attend only 2 days/week, the rest 3 days will be online sessions, Grade 6 will come
 to school on Sundays and Mondays starting from Sunday 21st Feb 2021, Grades 7 and 8 will come to
 school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays starting from Tuesday 23rd Feb 2021. Thursday is a day-off for
 the whole school (online sessions only).
- High school will attend only 2 days/week, the rest 3 days will be online sessions, Grades 10 and 11 will come to school on Sundays and Mondays starting from Sunday 21st Feb 2021, Grades 9 and 12 will come to school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays starting from Tuesday 23rd Feb 2021. Thursday is a day-off for the whole school (online sessions only).

Kindly abide to the following rules:

- All individuals entering, exiting and while on school campus must wear face masks.
- Students must bring their own personal hygiene kit to school. The kit includes: Face masks/shields Alcohol based sanitizing wipes Alcohol rub or hand sanitizers Tissues
- Students and staff are encouraged to wash their hands and use hand sanitizers regularly during school day.
- Gates will be closed at 8:00 am sharp, no student will be allowed to enter after this time.

DROP OFF GATES: Gate 2 and Gate 9 (ONLY)

• Students' dismissal is at 3:00 pm. After half an hour waiting fees will be charged.

PICK UP GATES: Gate 2: KG Students

Gate 3: Elementary Gr.1&Gr.2

Gate 9: Elementary Gr.3&Gr.4&Gr.5

Gate 1: Middle and High school Students

• No parent is allowed to enter school during dropping off/ picking up times.

• Students should bring their ID Cards, for gate students, parents/guardians/person in charge should show students' ID Cards at picking up gates.

• Early leave permission should be written and addressed to the respective stage director otherwise will not be accepted.

Still, this is a challenging time for all of us and we are certain that together we can cooperate and work on assuring the safety and educational effectiveness as your daughters return to school.
